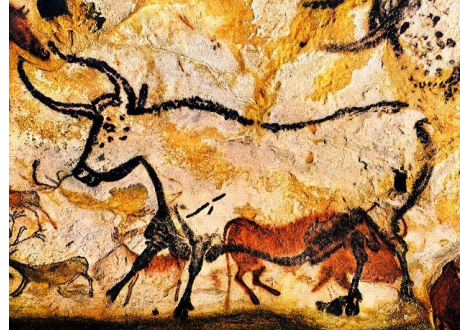


Take-Away Task Spring 2021

Our topic this term is 'Who were the first Britons?' We will be focussing on the Stone Age to Iron Age time periods.



Over the next half term I would like you to create a model of Stonehenge – the following are some ideas you could use but you can come up with your own ideas.

- a) Clayhenge: shape the different sized stones with their hands using clay or playdough, using a paper plate as a base.
- b) Biscuithenge: rectangular biscuits make great Stonehenge models. We suggest shortbread fingers for the larger sarsen stones and bourbons or pink wafers for the smaller sarsen stones. In contrast, use marshmallows or a smaller biscuit like iced gems for the bluestones to demonstrate the relative size difference. Add icing to help the lintel structures stick together.
- c) Boxhenge: For a slightly larger model, collect cereal boxes or boxes from other packaging.
