English

Reading and Writing

We will be looking at the short film of 'Tadeo Jones' and using this as a stimulus for writing explanation texts about archaeology and exploring. We will also be reading and discussing poems with different styles to create our own poems.

<u>SPAG</u>

The children will develop their knowledge of using fronted adverbials, punctuate direct speech and use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause.

History

We will be journeying back to the land of Pharaohs to discover the fascinating world of Ancient Egypt. We will be learning about: the River Nile and its role in ancient life; Tutankhamen and the story of his tomb discovery; the grisly process of mummification; the pyramids; daily life in ancient Egypt and the importance of remaining artefacts.

<u>PE</u>

This half term the children will be focusing on Netball. We will learn the essential skills needed to play netball such as dribbling with the ball, passing and keeping possession. We will cover attaching and defending tactics such as two-touch passing, learning when to pass and when to dribble and different techniques for tackling and marking.

Art

The children will be using their knowledge and understanding of Ancient Egyptian to design and create death masks. They will use different techniques and materials and will explore some history of art.

How many miles is the Nile?

This term during PSHE pupils will be learning about growing up and changing. The children will be encouraged to think about and discuss changes in their bodies and lives since they were babies. They will also learn about the changes that will happen over the coming years, including how the human body changes during puberty

PSHE

What do Christians mean when they talk about the Kingdom of God?

RE

The children will engage with the idea of kings and kingdoms and enquire into the Christian belief that Jesus is king. They will explore Christian ideas about the Kingdom of God in, Biblical Narrative, church practice and Christian living. This learning will be expressed through art, crafts and discussion.

<u>Maths</u>

The children will be following the NCETM ready to progress scheme to consolidate their Maths learning. We will be focusing on Number, Place Value and Numbers facts.

Computing

We will be using our computing skills to plan and create our own multimedia presentations, including text, pictures, and sounds, about a particular aspect of Ancient Egyptian life. We will also look at how we can use search engines safely to find out answers to specific questions about Ancient Egypt.

<u>French</u>

In French this half term we will be exploring the theme 'our school.'

We will learn key vocabulary and phrases around the theme of the school, including what's in your classroom, items in your pencil cases and school subjects.
