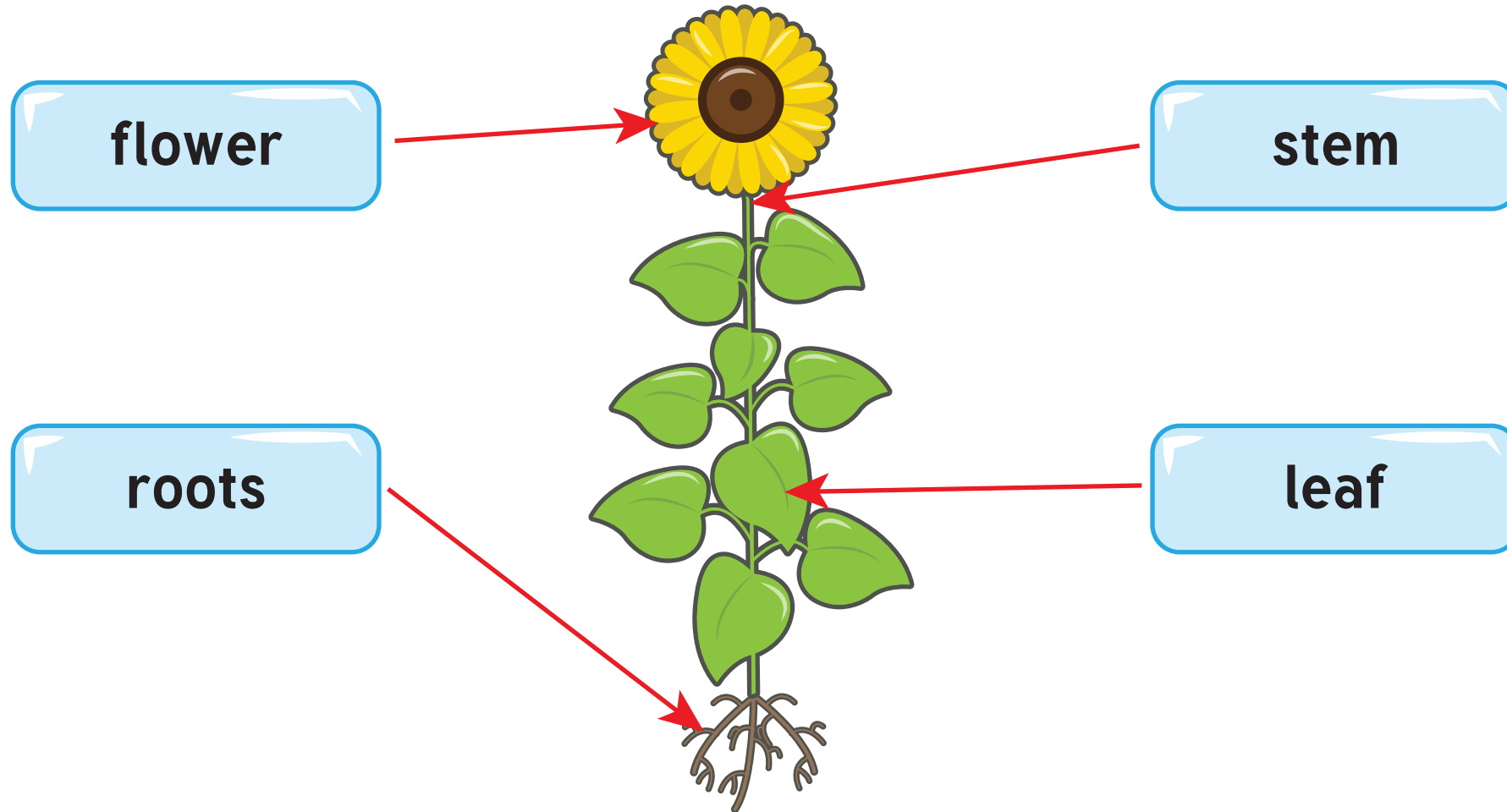

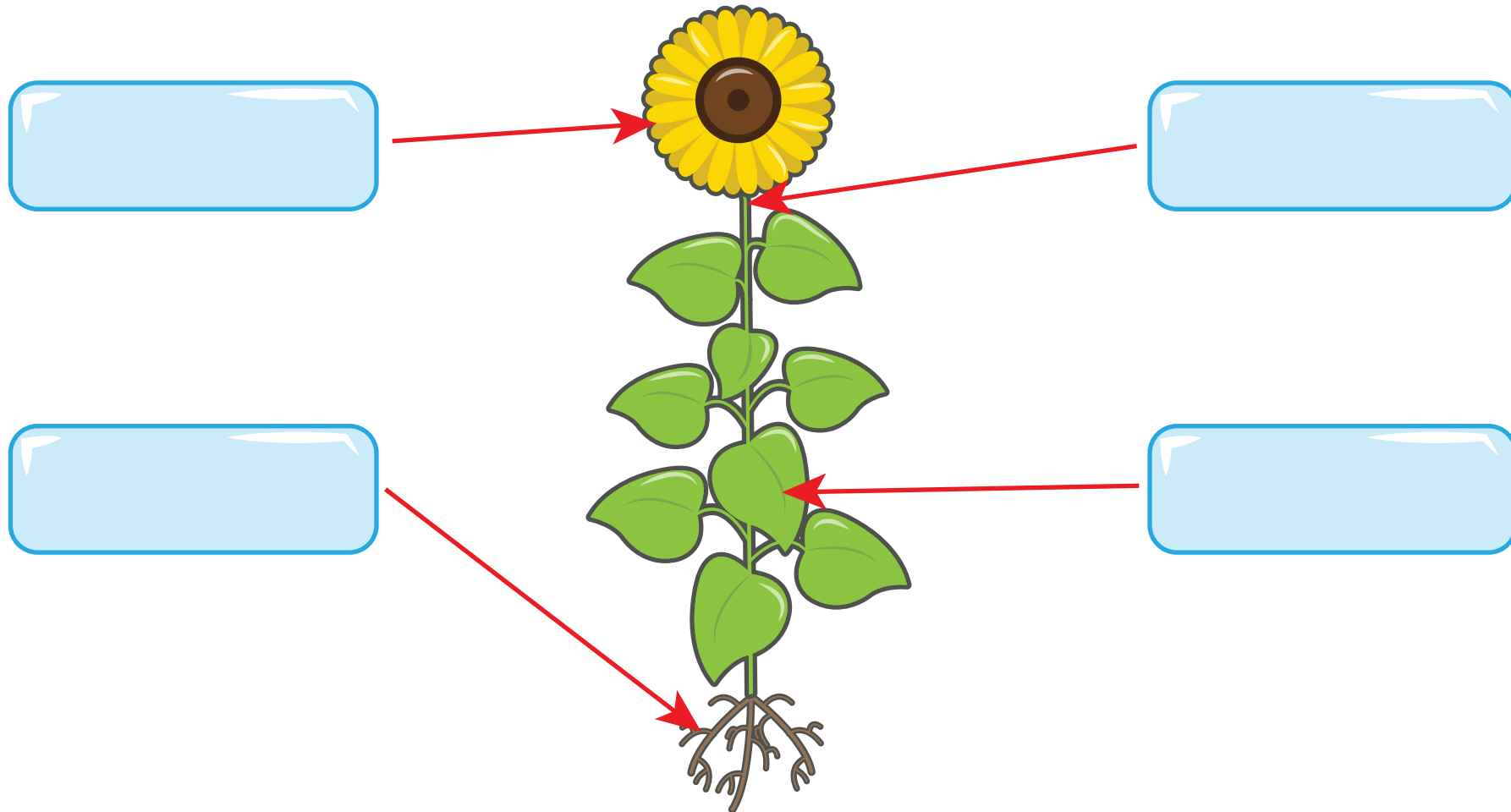

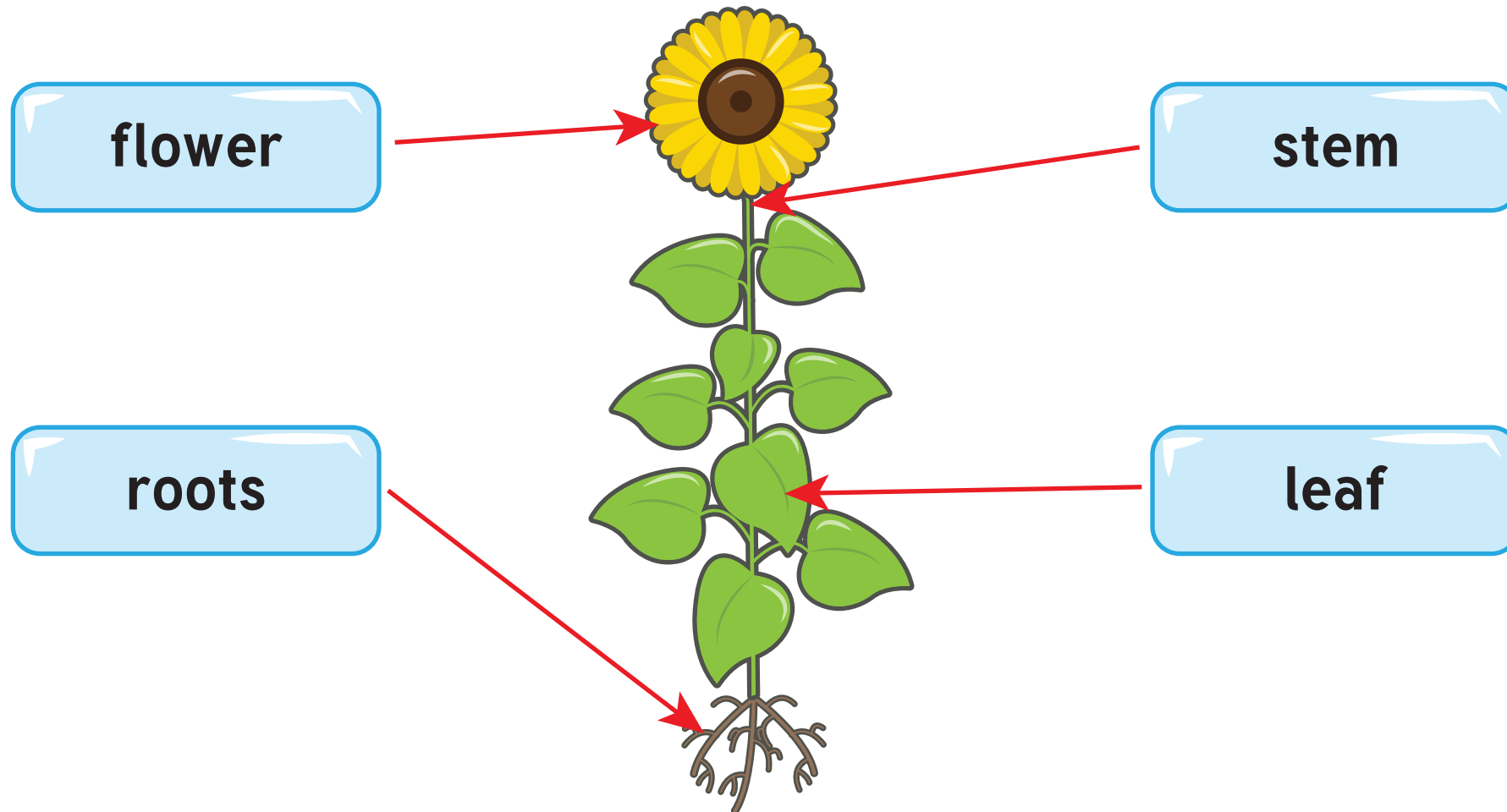

## Flower

The flower is brightly coloured to attract birds and insects.

## Stem

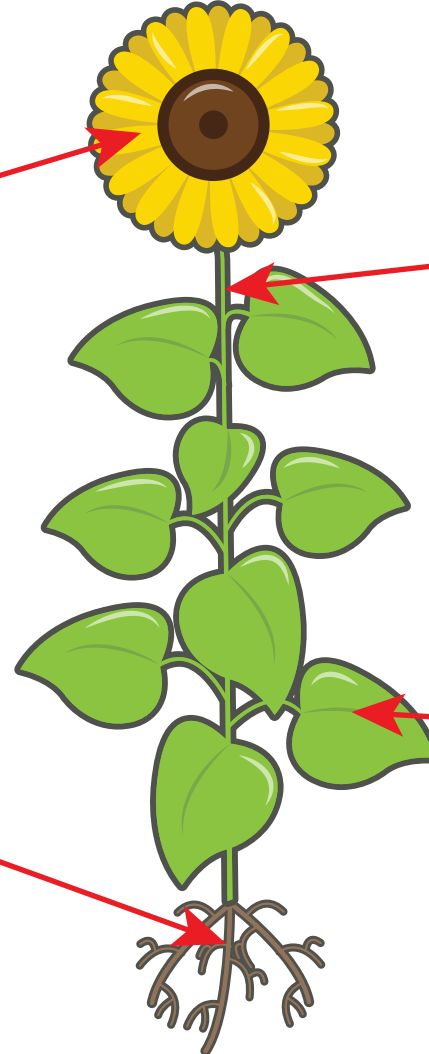
The stem holds the plant up

## Roots

The roots take in water and nutrients from the soil.

## Leaf

The leaf catches sunlight so the plant can make its own food.

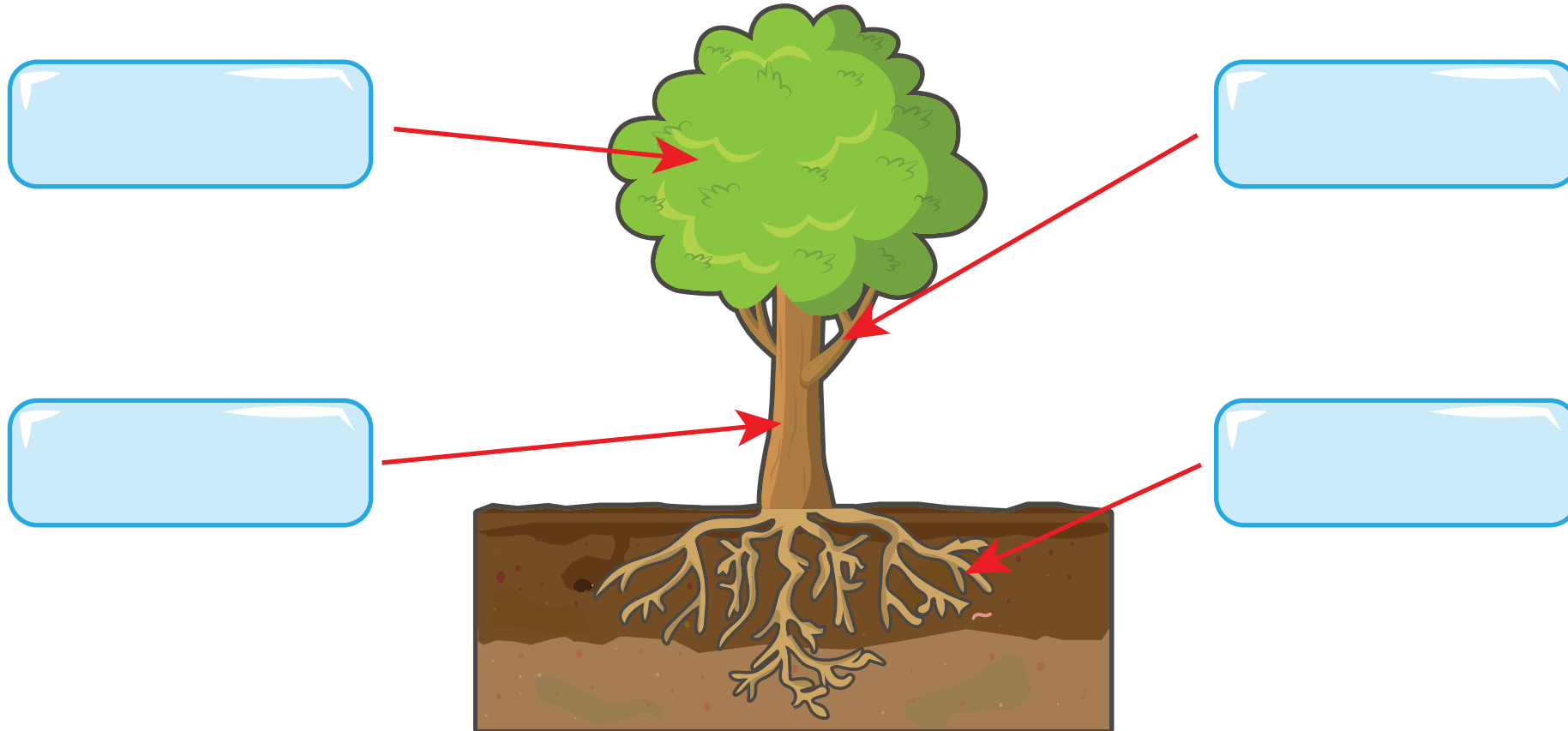

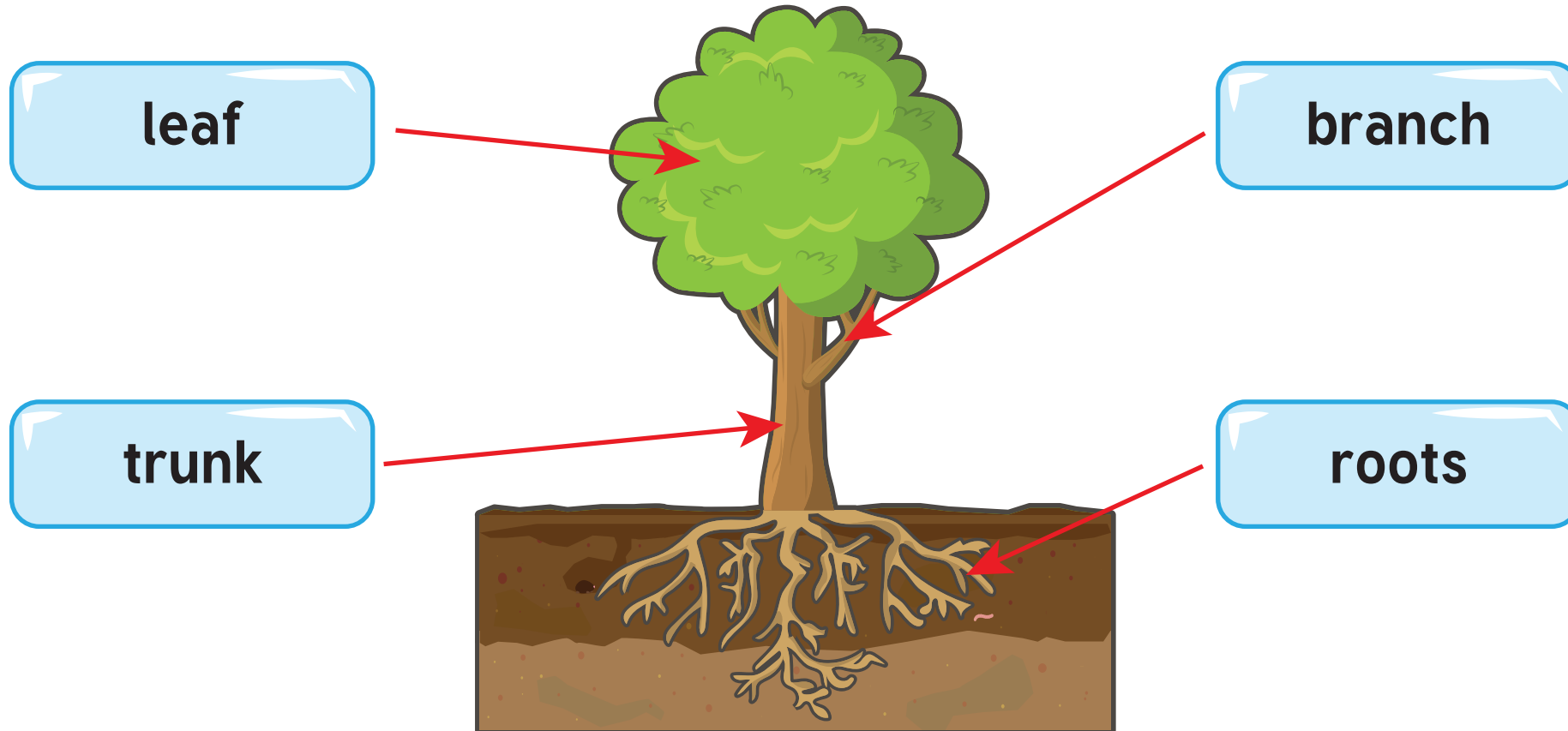
